Originally built in the 1800s as a mining cabin, the velvet-seated Steakhouse No. 316 these days feels right for a spendy and snowed-in dinner. Kale salad — described by the proprietors as the best in town — is a good start to the meal. (It's named after Lulu, a ghost who supposedly haunts the building.) What follows next will be a display of riches — steaks topped in things like lobster tail, king crab legs, and bone marrow butter. This restaurant is the second of a local group that also includes the Wild Fig, the Monarch, and CP Burger.
